Changes in Animal Drop-Off Procedures Due to COVID-19 Health Crisis

Thank you for supporting WildCare! Because of the current public health emergency, we've made several changes in the past week at WildCare. We will continue to provide care for our animals and answer the hundreds of calls and messages we receive each week from the public.

However, members of the public bringing ill, orphaned, or injured animals are asked to leave the animal in a secured box, cage, or carrier, return to their car, and call WildCare (405-872-9338). There are carriers next to the front door for use by the public. If they are unable to safely leave the animal by the front door, they should call WildCare and a staff member wearing Personal Protective Equipment will get the animal from the car while the member of the public waits in the vehicle.

If the situation changes, we will inform you. Please take care of yourselves and thank you again for supporting WildCare Foundation and the injured, ill, and orphaned wildlife we care for each year with your help.
